For construction sites:

- Maintain inventory
- Review plans
- Conduct inspections
- Report non-filers





Uniform Requirements

All MS4s:

- Require proof of CGP coverage
- Have a stormwater ordinance*
- Conduct construction site inspections
- * Except ADOT
