

What is STORM?




STORM is a not-for-profit organization promoting stormwater education within the greater Phoenix Metropolitan area

- 2. Storm
- 3. Sewer
- 4. Systems





MS4 Permits

Cities and other entities with storm sewer systems have permits from ADEQ for stormwater discharges to waters of the US.



MS4 Permit Requirements

For construction sites:

- Maintain inventory
- Review plans
- Conduct inspections
- Open up that SWPPP!
- Report non-filers





Uniform Requirements

All MS4s:

- Require grading and drainage plans
- Have a stormwater ordinance*
- Conduct construction site inspections
- * Except ADOT



Inspections

Different MS4s inspect:

- At different minimum frequencies
- Enforcing different local ordinances
- Using different types of inspectors





Remember:

- Any construction site inspector may cite for stormwater violations
- ADEQ or EPA may also inspect at any time
